Annual Report by the Jt Director, TIPS, Dwarka.

I am privileged to place before you the Annual Report in respect of Trinity Institute of Professional Studies for the year 2014-15.

Trinity Institute of Professional Studies, Dwarka was set up in the year 2007 under the aegis of Kamal Educational and Welfare Society in affiliation with GGSIP University with three-year degree courses in the disciplines of BJMC, BBA (General) and BCA with intake of 60 students in each course. TIPS, Dwarka was granted affiliation to run another degree course, namely, BBA (Banking & Insurance) from the session 2008-09. Further the second shift for all the courses at TIPS, Dwarka started from the session 2009-10. The Institute started B.Com (Hons) course from the session 2013-14 with intake of 60 students and is increased to 180 from the year 2014-15.

From the academic session 2014-15, the Institute exchanged BBA (Banking & Insurance) with B.Com (Hons) in both the shifts. At present, TIPS, Dwarka is having sanctioned strength of about 1540 students in different under-graduate courses in two shifts.

Today is 7th Degree Distribution Ceremony and about 406 students are entitled and eligible to get their degrees who passed out their different under-graduate courses in 2015 from Trinity institute of Professional Studies.

For kind information and benefit of our hon'ble guests I would like to mention here that the Trinity Institute Dwarka is set up with the mission to provide cutting edge technical and professional higher education in the disciplines of management, computer science, mass communication and commerce .

Through this Report, I pay tribute to a great visionary, the founder of the Trinity Institute of Professional Studies and Kamal Educational and Welfare Society, Late Shri O.P. Tandon whom we lost in the year 2009. He lives no more, but his work done inspires all of us and his dreams live on and on. He would have been happy in seeing this gathering of students receiving their degrees from the Hon'ble Chief Guest. In the memory of the founder father, Kamal Educational & Welfare Society has introduced Shri O.P. Tandon Memorial "Best Teacher-Scholar Award" from the academic session 2010-11. In the Annual Convocations of 2012 and 2013, the then Vice Chancellor of GGSIPU handed over the said Award to first and second recipient respectively.

A vibrant institute is known by its achievements and initiatives:

TIPS, Dwarka is graded as "A+" Category institute by the SFRC, Department of Higher Education, Govt of NCT of Delhi. TIPS, Dwarka is an ISO 9001-2008 certified institution.

Trinity Institute of Professional Studies came out with a Annual Research Journal titled, "Trinity Journal of Management, IT & Media" from the year 2010 and it got ISSN Number in 2012.

TIPS also publish an on-line bi-annual News Letter titled "TRINITY TIMES" showcasing the important activities held in each semester of a particular academic session. Upto the academic year 2015-16, we have published 17 issues of Trinity Times.

The Mass Comm Department of Trinity Institute of Professional Studies, Dwarka launched tri-annual community newspaper 'VOICE OF TRINITY'. It highlights and focuses the places, people and events in Dwarka Sub City.

TIPS organized their fifth National Conference on "Innovations in E-Commerce, Management, IT & Media on 21st February 2015 and sixth National Conference "Digital India :Recent Paradigm shift in IT,Media and Management" on March 19th 2016. We received 93 research papers for the fifth national conference and

103 research papers for the 6th national conference. Approximately 200 academicians, researchers, corporate professionals and students participated in each of the conference.

A number of co-curricular activities such as, Inter-Departmental Debate Competition, Talent Hunt, Free Counseling sessions by the Art of Living, Quiz Competition, Blood Bank Donation Camp and other student centric activities like Teachers' Day Celebration, Diwali Celebration, etc. were arranged in both the institutes in the two academic sessions.

With the annual grant of Delhi Government, the Eco Club of the two institutions organized a number of activities, like "Eco-Quiz", "Eco Poster Making Competition", and spread the message of preserving the environment.

Besides Eco Club, Trinity Institute has formed some other Clubs to motivate the students for showcasing their talents. These clubs are: Technology Club, Media Club, Sports club, Performing Artists' Club and Alumni Club.

Students of TIPS institute undertook Excursion – cum – Study Tours during the academic year and covered ; Kullu-Manali Rohtang Pass; Kullu-Manali Manikaran; Nainital Jim Corbett National Park; and Dalhousie & Khajjar. The students also undertook a number of industrial visits.

Interactive Career Counselling sessions were held for students of TIPS in the months of March and April in 2015. Mass Communication students of TIPS, Dwarka visited different media houses. To name a few, our students visited NDTV, Doordarshan, Zee TV, CNBC, IBN, Central Production Centre of Doordarshan, News Service Division of All India Radio and other private channels of TV and Radio.

The Placement committee has successfully placed 125 students in the academic year 2014-2015. The highest package for final placements was that of 3.00 Lakh per annum given by Grofers company. The major recruiters for the students of Trinity have been Wipro technologies, Tech Mahindra, Infosys, TCS, Grofers, Aon, HDFC bank etc. A variety of jobs in the area of IT, sales, marketing, customer care and content writing were offered to the students of TIPS. A total of

20 workshops and seminars were conducted in TIPS in the session 2014-15 in which the students were exposed to various areas of Management ,IT, and Mass communications. Also the institute organized many industrial visits for students to get a practical exposure to the corporate world, some of which were visits to Mother Dairy and Door Darshan offices.

Though, the students of TIPS have won gold, silver and bronze medals in different events every year in the annual cultural festival of GGSIP University titled “Anugoonj” I would like to make a special mention of Zorks, The Street Dance Group of TIPS, Dwarka who won the coveted First position third time in a row and completed their hat-trick in the finals of Anugoonj 2015.

Similarly in the annual sports meet of GGSIP University held in November 2015 , the students of TIPS won Three gold medals ,five silver medals and two bronze medals.

Seven of our faculty members authored/released books during this academic year. They include Dr Jaspreet Kaur,Dr Shaily Saxena,Ms Reena Yadav and Ms Rupakshi from Department of Management, Dr. B.P. Singh ,Ms Natasha and Ms Sakshi Goel from the Department of IT & Computer Science.

Apart from the above achievements I would like to make a special mention of Ms. Reema Tandon, esteemed Member of Kamal & Trinity Group of Educational Institutions and Vice Chairperson of TIPS, Dwarka who was the recipient of “Meri Dilli Award 2014” in the area of education. The award for her outstanding contribution in the area of education in NCT of Delhi was conferred by Dr. Harsh Vardhan, Hon’ble Minister of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India. On the other hand our Chairman Dr. R.K. Tandon is recipient of a number of awards and honours like Avantika Rajiv Gandhi Excellence in Education Award; Global Human Rights Protection Award; Manav Rattan Samman Award; Dr. S. Radhakrishnan Memorial Award; Dr. Rajendra Prasad Award as eminent educationist; Delhi State Teachers’ Award; twice Dr. S. Radhakrishnan Shikshak Ratna Samman, etc.
