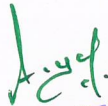


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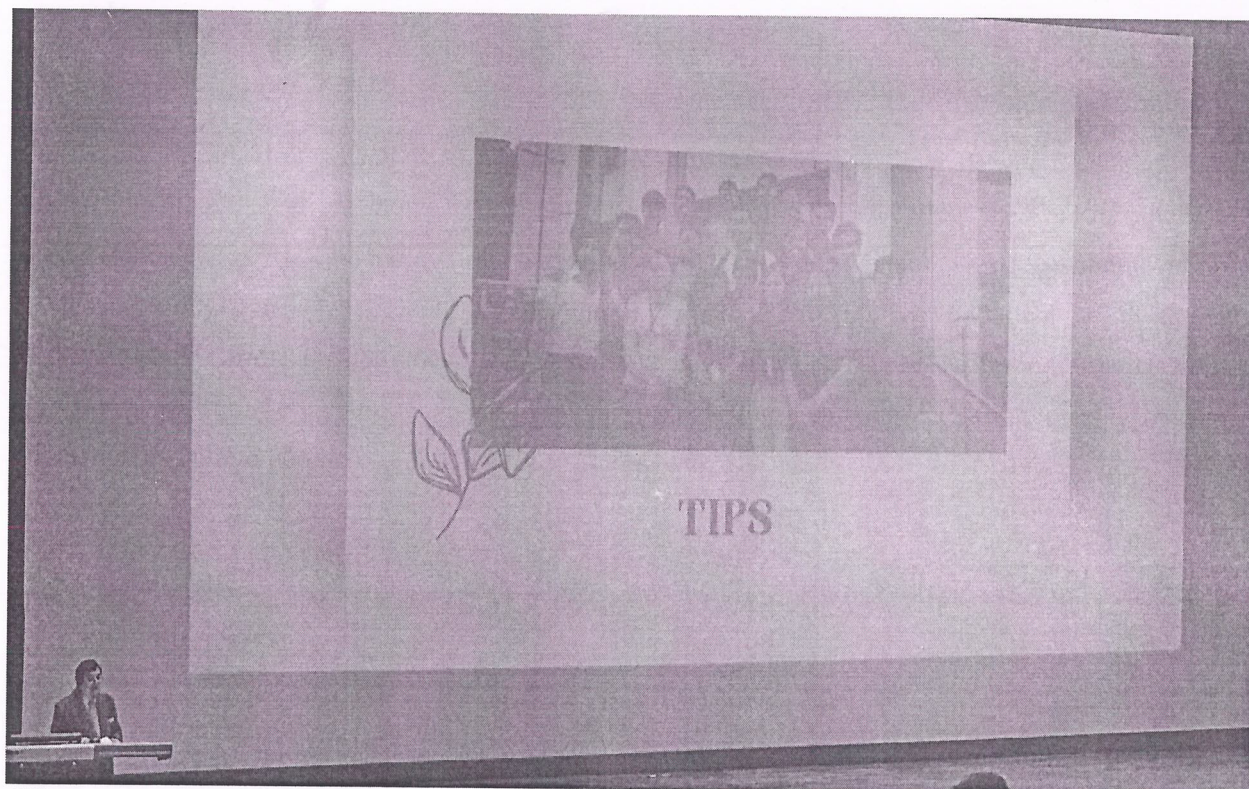

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SILVER JUBILEE GRAND ALUMNI MEET

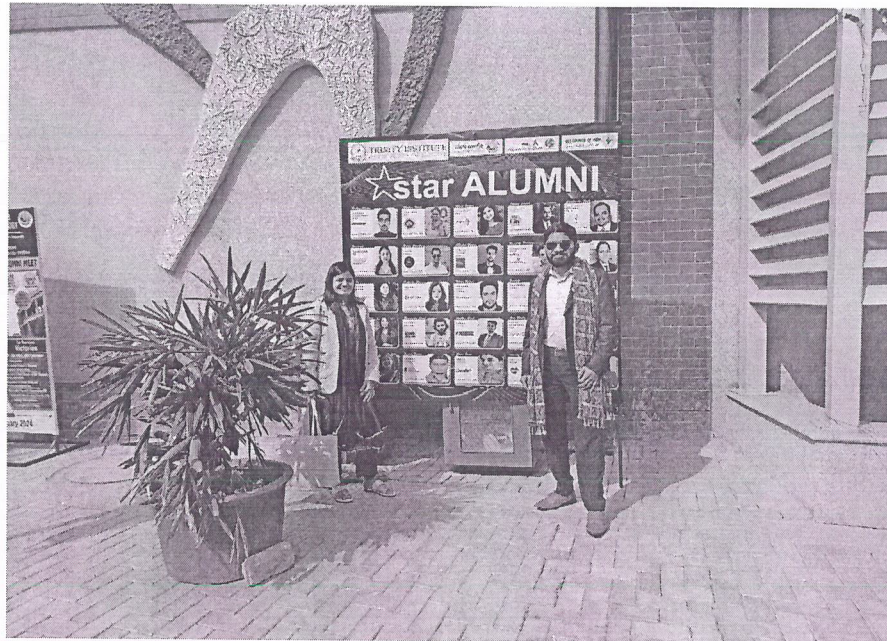
18th February 2024

This session helped the students as he elaborated few factors like:-

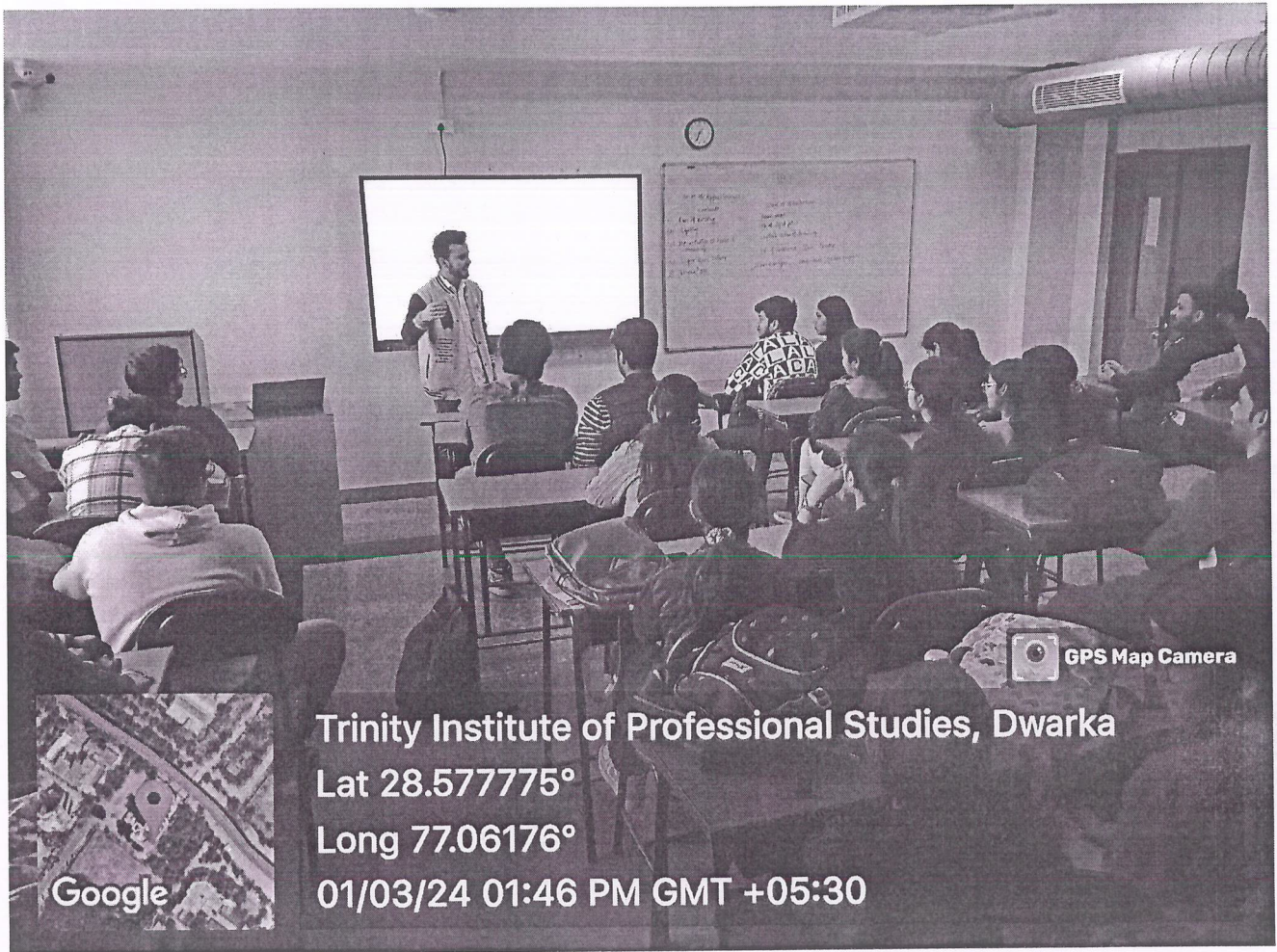
- a) risk-free investments

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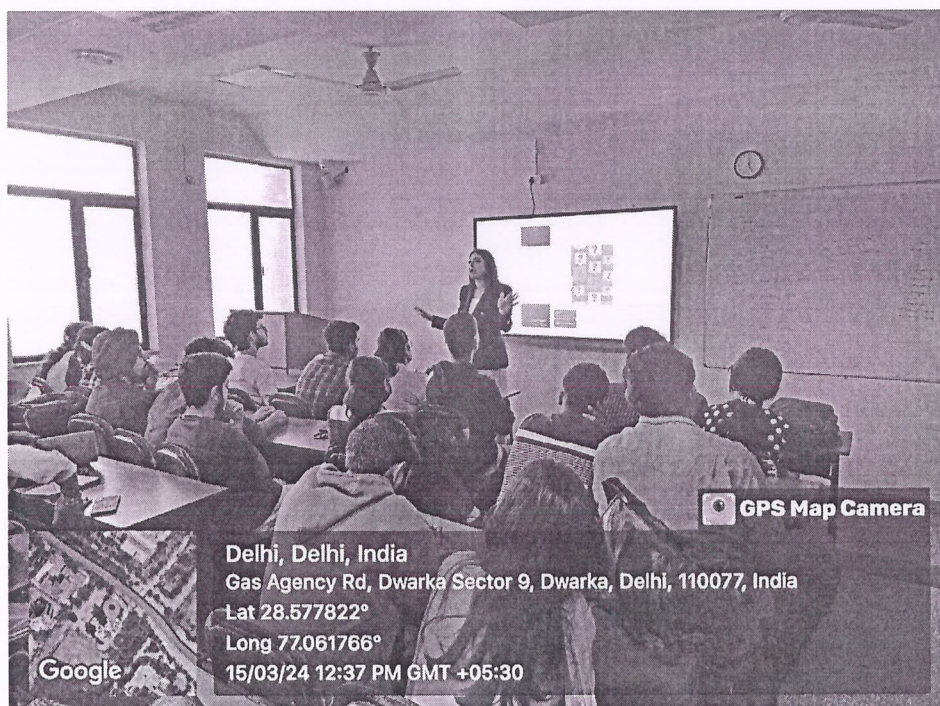
A Report on Alumni Interaction Session

March 15th, 2024

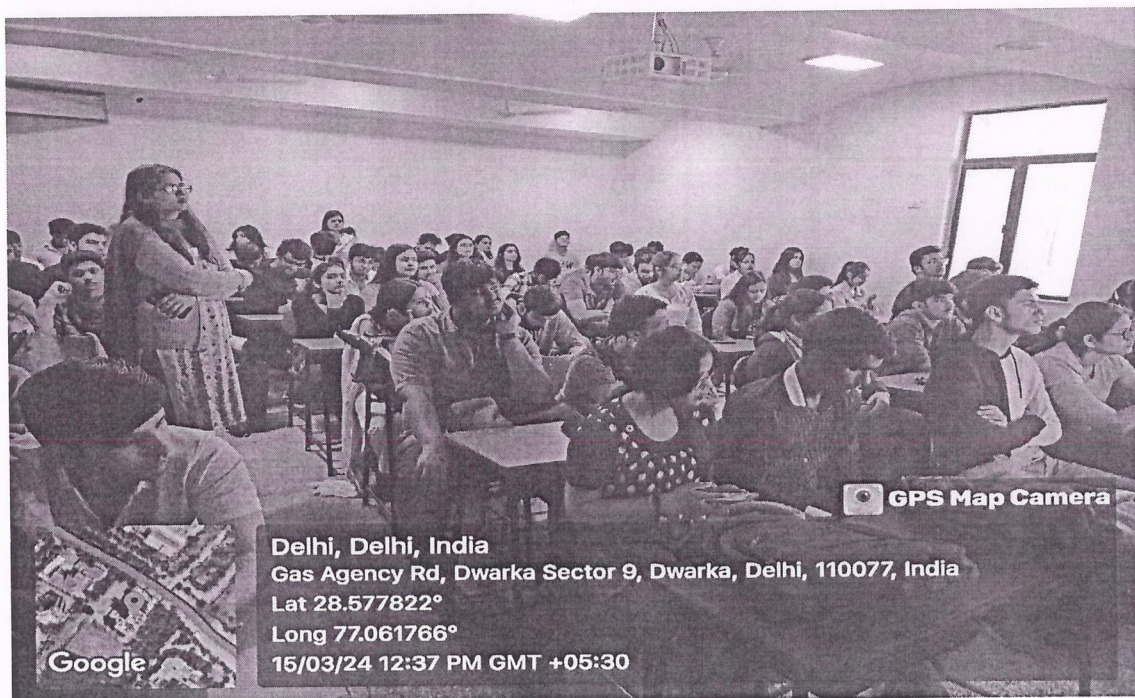
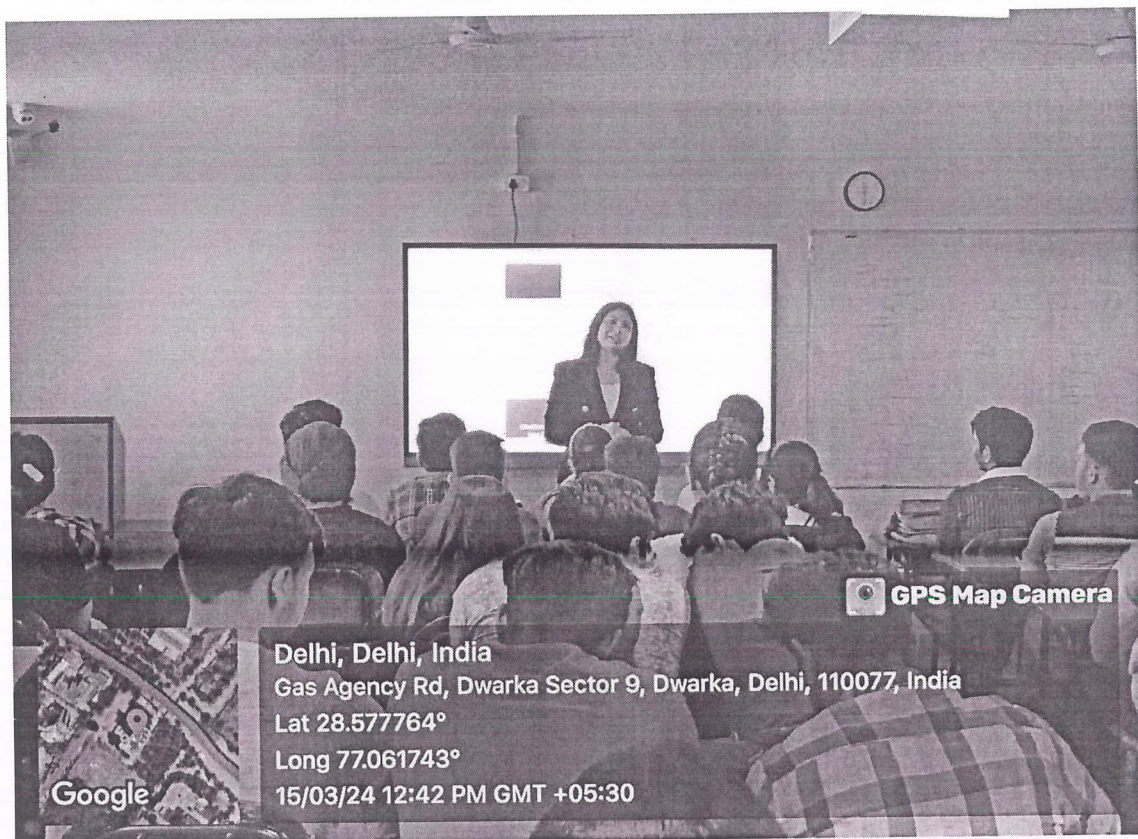

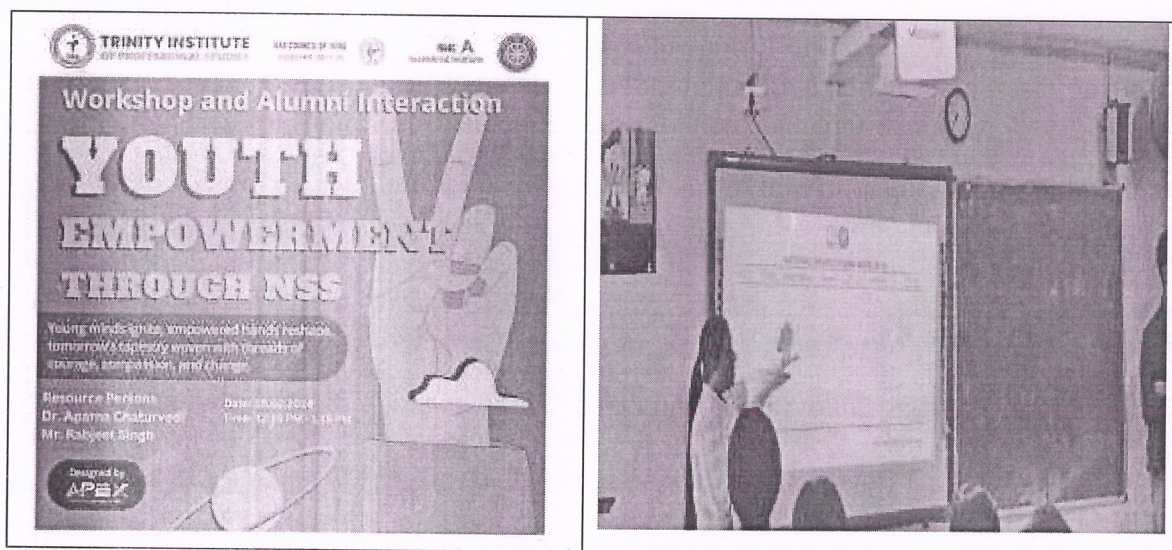
16th Feb, 2024
