Water conservation facilities available in the Institution:

The institution is committed to sustainable water management by implementing advanced measures to conserve and replenish water resources.

Key Water Conservation Initiatives:

1. Rainwater Harvesting:

- A fully operational Rainwater Harvesting System effectively recharges underground water levels and mitigates groundwater depletion.

2. Borewell/Open Well Recharge:

- The system channels harvested rainwater into borewells, reducing the demand for potable water and augmenting groundwater reserves.

3. Construction of Tanks and Bunds:

- Overhead water tanks on rooftops ensure consistent freshwater supply. RO systems and water filters provide clean drinking water to the campus community.

4. Wastewater Recycling:

- RO wastewater is innovatively redirected to toilet flush tanks, conserving significant amounts of water daily.

5. Maintenance of Water Bodies and Distribution System:

- Regular cleaning of overhead tanks every three months ensures water quality. The institution maintains an Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) for the RO system to ensure peak performance.

Impact:

These initiatives have significantly reduced water consumption, minimized wastewater, and improved water quality. The institution's proactive approach ensures compliance with environmental standards and sets a model for sustainable practices.

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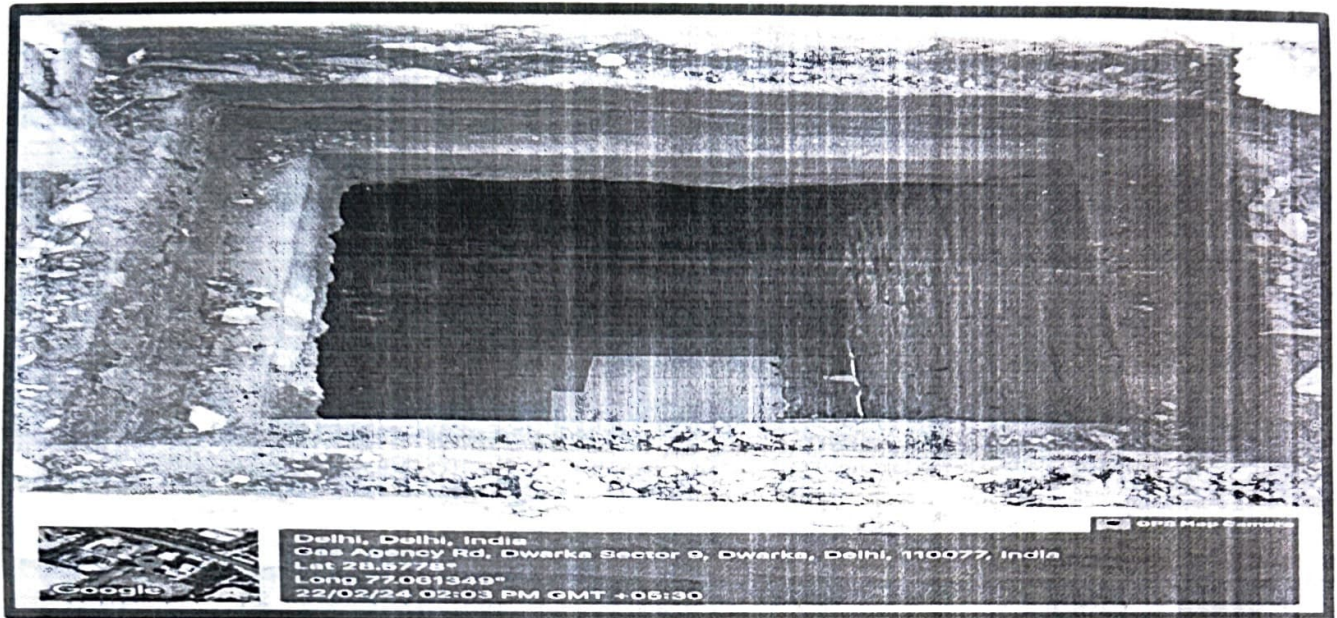


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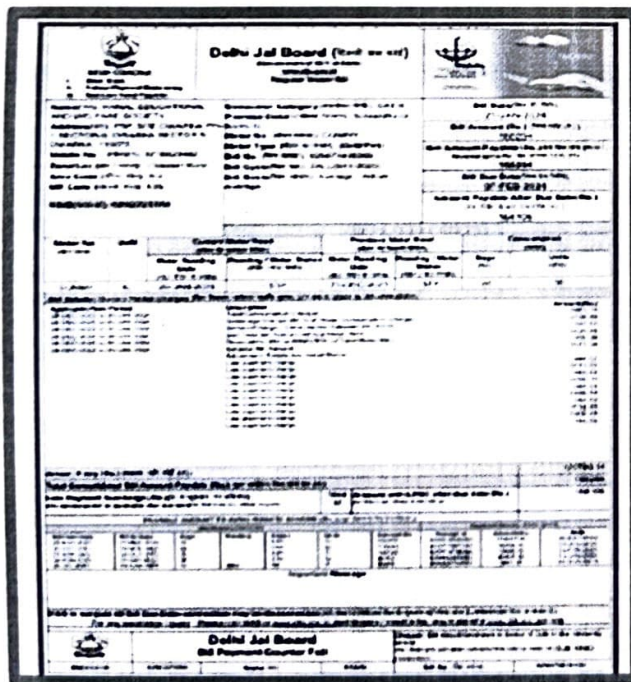

A photograph depicting water conservation facilities



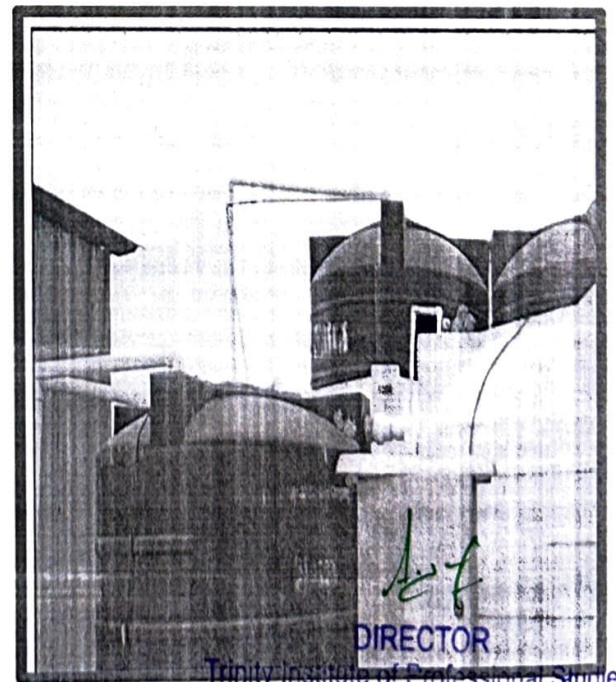

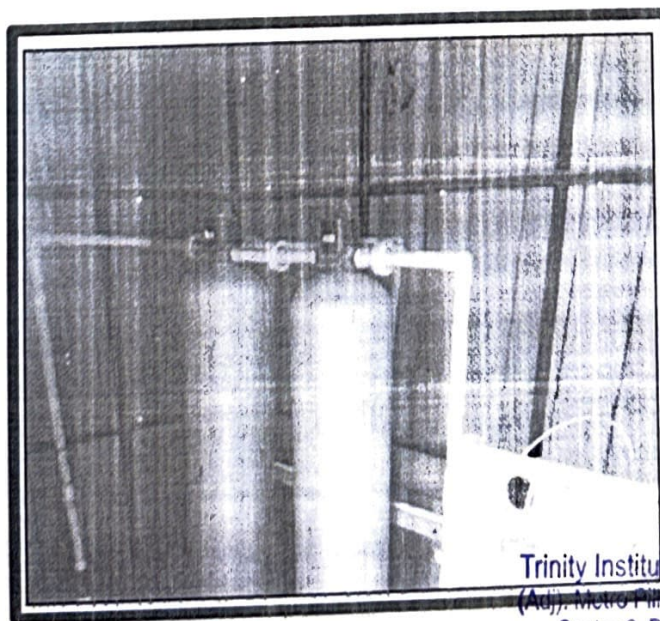
