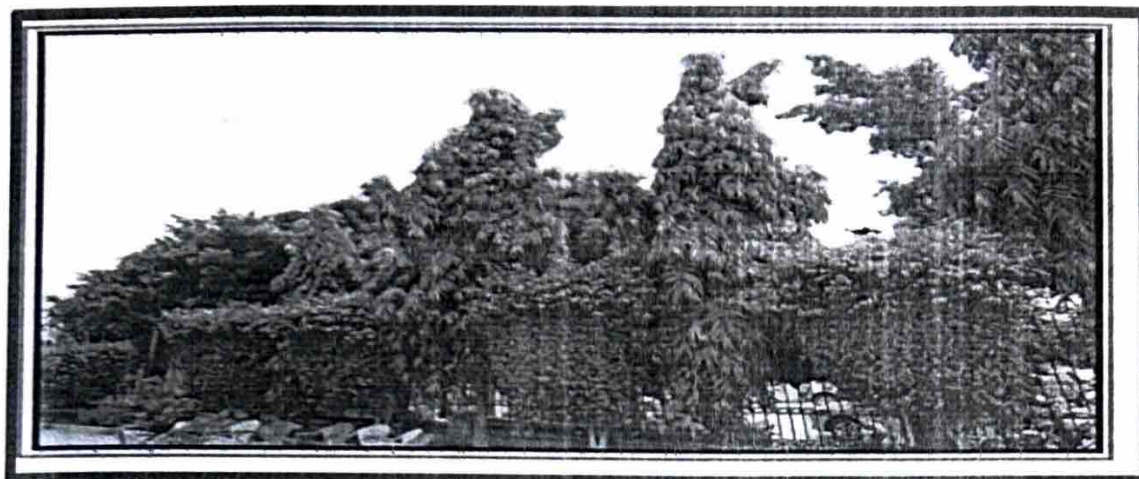

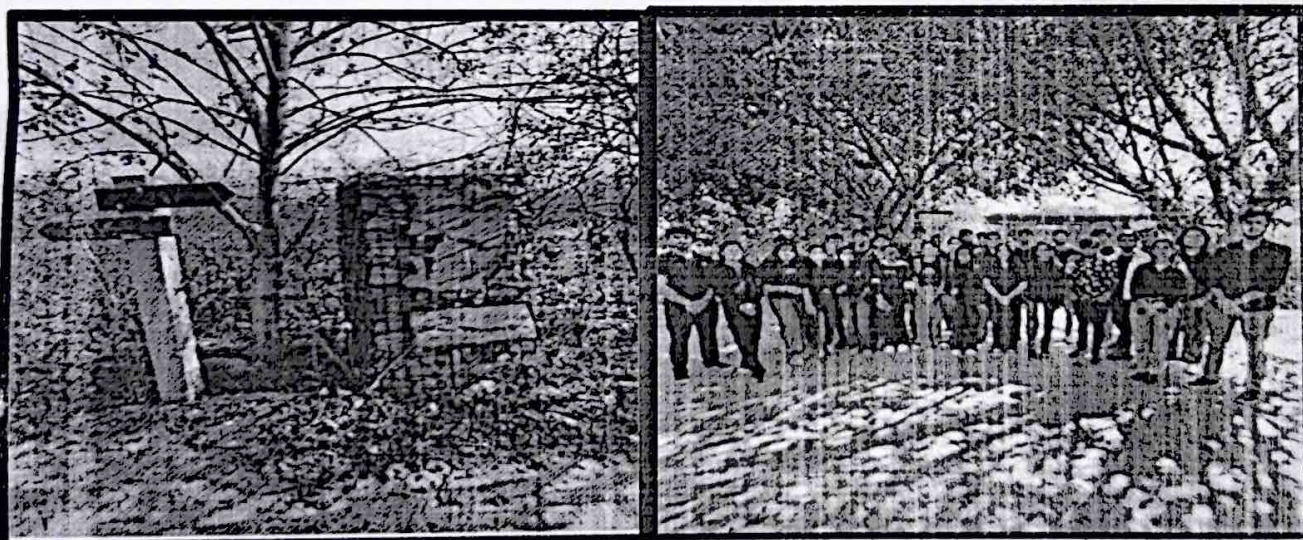
Activity : Visit to Nature Walk- Aravali Biodiversity Reserve

Date: 5 th June, 2024

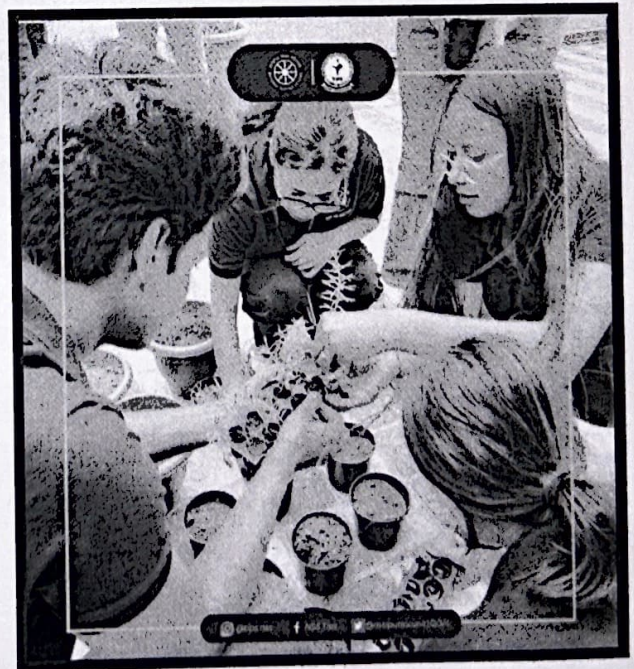
Aims/Objectives : Fostering environmental awareness and conservation
