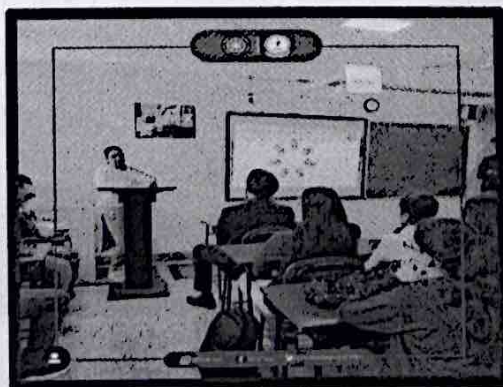

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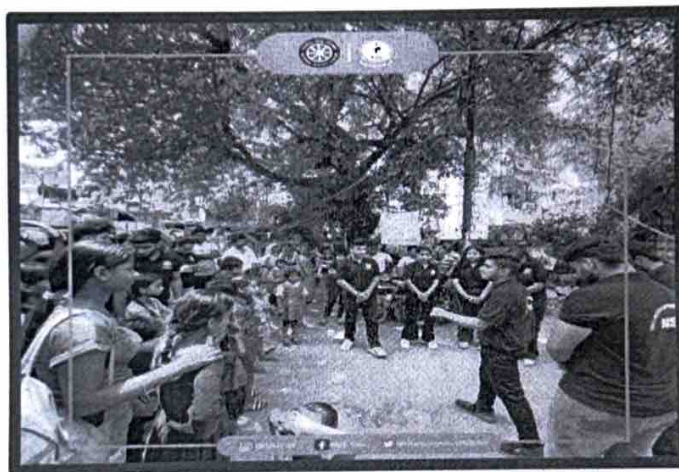
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Summary of the Activity:

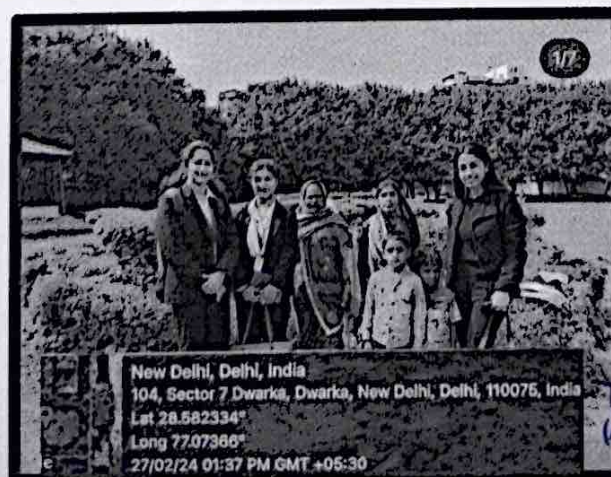

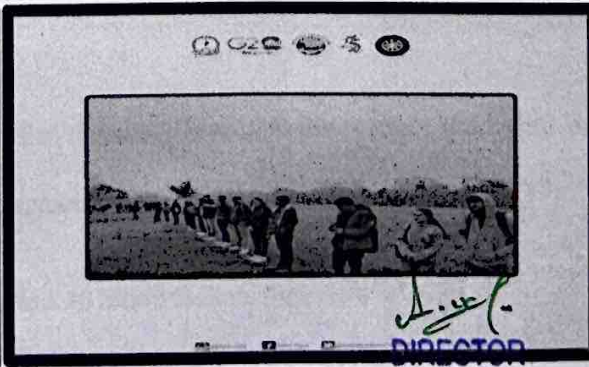
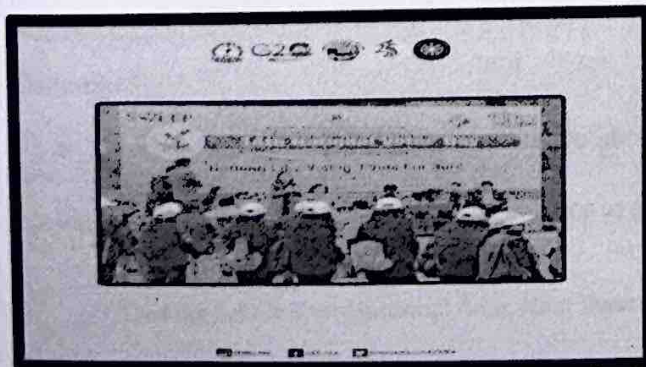

- The event encouraged proactive behavior to safeguard against cybercrimes.

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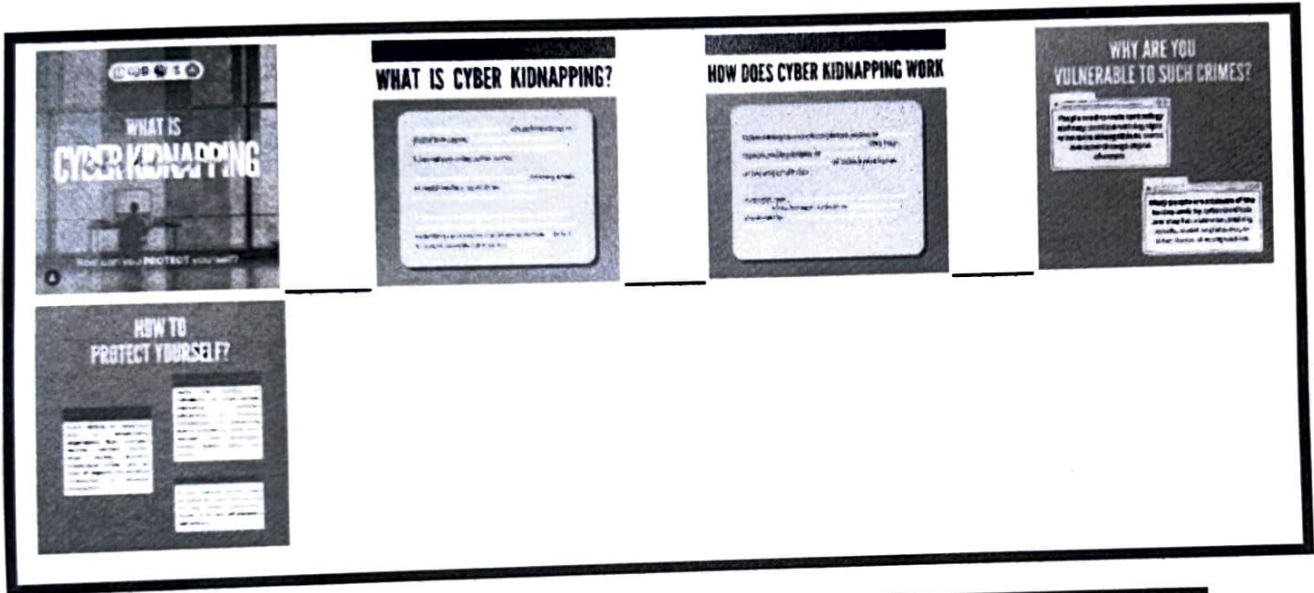
